	220326	LADY BADEN POWELL PIN	\$ 3.95	Presented by the Unit Guider to Guides who have completed the challenge requirements. This is the highest award in the Guide Program.
	420600	MENTORING PIN	\$ 2.85	The pin represents participation in the Mentoring program giving Guiders the ability to fly while staying connected solidly to a sister in Guiding. Suggested presentation is at the fall or at the beginning of the mentoring relationship but whatever works best for the council is acceptable.
	420601	OAL GO CAMPING PIN	\$ 1.25	Earned by Unit Guiders who have completed OAL training and the requirement for overnight camping with girls.
	420621	TEAM - TRAINER LAMP PIN	\$ 3.25	Trainer upon completion of Trainer stream modules and satisfactory assessment of trainer competencies.
	420622	TEAM - UNIT GUIDER PIN (RED)	\$ 3.25	Unit Guider upon completion of pre-requisite and foundation modules.
	420623	TEAM - DISTRICT COMMISSIONER PIN (ORANGE)	\$ 3.25	District Commissioner (and Commissioners of all levels) upon completion of pre-requisite and foundation modules.

With approval from the Chief Commissioner, this award may also be given to staff that are members of teams or committees that are primarily made up of Member-volunteers. A Member or Staff may receive the Team Award more than once.

The award is granted by the council concerned and has three levels. Bronze is for 1 to 3 years experience.

This award is granted by the council concerned and can be presented during a Member's tenure or upon retirement.
	420767	CHIEF COMMISSIONER BRONZE AWARD	\$ 2.50	Presented to Rangers after completion of nine challenges from at least four different program areas.
	420768	CHIEF COMMISSIONER SILVER AWARD	\$ 2.50	Presented to Rangers after completion of nine additional challenges from at least four areas.
	420769	CHIEF COMMISSIONER GOLD AWARD	\$ 5.50	Presented to Rangers upon completion of the bronze and silver levels including at least one challenge from each area and the following: The Cookie Campaign Challenge and/or The Ranger Service Project. This is the highest award a girl can earn as a Ranger.
	420771	SPARK GUIDER APPOINTMENT PIN	\$ 2.95	A Member is appointed to her position as a Spark Guider by an ACL or a Commissioner. She may be presented with an appointment pin for the position.
	420772	GUIDE GUIDER APPOINTMENT PIN	\$ 2.95	A Member is appointed to her position as Guide Guider by an ACL or a Commissioner. She may be presented with an appointment pin for the position.

Girls receive their Membership pin from their Guider or Commissioner and Adult Members receive their pin from their District Commissioner. After 15 years of service, pins are awarded every five years.

	520314	CANADA CORD PIN WITH RIBBON	\$ 12.00	Awarded in Pathfinders third year for completion of the challenge requirements by the Unit Guider with the support of her District. It is the highest award a girl can earn as a Pathfinder.
	520319	COMMUNITY SERVICE PIN	\$ 2.25	This is presented to Pathfinders by the Unit Guider upon completion of 15 hours of community service projects. This is one requirement for earning the Canada Cord.
	620311	RANGER COOKIE CAMPAIGN PIN	\$ 3.25	This is earned by Rangers after taking a role in supporting at least four cookie campaigns.
	620312	RANGER SERVICE PIN	\$ 3.25	Presented to Ranger after completing one Ranger Service Project of at least 20 hours including planning.
	620900	METAL COMMONWEALTH AWARD	\$ 5.50	This award for Rangers was developed in 1985 at the Commonwealth Chief Commissioners' meeting to strengthen the bonds between Commonwealth countries. It is awarded by the Unit Guider for completion of the challenge.

	929970	BEAVER AWARD	\$ 74.95	The Beaver Award is granted by the Board of Directors to adult Members for exceptional service to Guiding at the provincial or national level. Except in special cases, it is awarded only to those who hold the Medal of Merit.
	929975	FORTITUDE AWARD	\$ 140.00	Presented by the Board of Directors to girl or adult Members who have shown great courage and endurance in adversity. The application comes from the Province to the Board.
	929980	HONORARY LIFE AWARD	\$ 140.00	The Honorary Life Award is granted by the Board of Directors to adult Members still actively involved in the organization or upon retirement. Applications must be submitted through the Commissioner concerned and accompanied by the required fee. Honorary Life Award recipients must comply with GGC conditions of membership as set out in the GGC Bylaws and Screening Policy, with the exception of paying the annual fee.
	929987	VALOUR AWARD - GOLD	\$ 200.00	Presented by the Board of Directors to a girl or adult Member who has shown heroism in risking her life to save or attempting to save a life of another person. The award has three levels. Gold for greatest heroism and risk to life.
	929988	VALOUR AWARD - SILVER	\$ 175.00	Presented by the Board of Directors to a girl or adult Member who has shown heroism in risking her life to save or attempting to save a life of another person. The award has three levels. Silver for considerable risk to life.
	929989	VALOUR AWARD - BRONZE	\$ 175.00	Presented by the Board of Directors to a girl or adult Member who has shown heroism in risking her life to save or attempting to save a life of another person. The award has three levels. Bronze for high risk to personal safety.
	929990	GOLD MAPLE LEAF AWARD	\$ 155.00	The Gold Maple Leaf Award is granted by the Board of Directors to adult Members for exceptional service to Guiding at the national level which contributes to the enrichment of Guiding in Canada. It is only awarded to those who hold the Beaver.
